As such, this positive enrolment bodes very well for our sports program for next year, both at the junior high level and in the MiniDunkers program. This means there will be more students available to try out for our junior high sports program. We are anticipating that Round Hill School will have boys' and girls' teams in both volleyball and basketball. I will be providing more detailed information at the School Council meeting on the 8th.





Sora offers the ability for students to explore age-appropriate digital books from Parkland Regional Library




Here's how to access titles from the library through Sora:
