5. Trustee Report – Karen Belich is now the Board of Trustees Chair; Karen spoke of how much of the work these past few months has been related to COVID-19 policies and procedures relating to the return to school.

6. Principals Report

- Brian Horbay reported that the current enrollment is 95, with 10 of those students enrolled in at-home learning. Students may be re-enter the school learning environment at any time, as opposed to waiting until each term is up. Students wishing to withdraw from the school and move to at-home learning must wait until a new term.
- Safety Protocols
 - Cohort Groups are Junior High, Grades 5/6, Grades 1-4, and Kindergarten.
 - Other measures include physical distancing, use of masks, hand sanitizer, restricted visitors, busses loading back to front, and increased cleaning by janitorial staff throughout the day.
 - No school pictures planned at this time.
 - Emergency Drills have been modified; fire drills are done separately by each class, and lock down drills are theoretical.
 - No Junior High Band at this time.
 - Junior High students will attend options at Camrose Comp, however, the class will remain in their Cohort and take 1 option course per term.
 - No sports competitions as of yet, just practices at this point. Brian Horbay and Stacey Hartinger will share coaching at Volleyball practices.

- No Provincial Achievement Tests.
- What to do if your child is sick? Go home and take the COVID-19 online assessment to determine if they need a test. Follow the AHS procedures as per guidelines on returning to school.
- Breakfast program will be classroom specific and needs to be pre-packaged food only. The past program coordinator is Birdie Robert and she will be contacted to see about doing the first purchase.
