5. Principal's Report- Brain Horbay (see attached)
 - a. No Remembrance Day Ceremony at the School
 - b. Student Population started with 95, 2 withdrew 93
 - c. Covid News; all classes back in person, still considered an outbreak school until November 17. Deep clean has been done at the school, extra cleaning done during the day, every day. Hand sanitizing, masks, all staff double vaccinated. No visitors into the school without proof of vaccine, or valid negative Covid test.

 - g.  - h. 3 year plan remains very similar- continue to infuse agriculture and focus on math and literacy.
