May Events:

During the week of May 6-10 the students at school practiced their **Tornado drill**. We will also have two more fire drills before the end of the school year.

Round Hill Junior High students (7-9) are going to Bawlf School on Wednesday, May 15th to see a presentation by **Sam Demma**. The four key points to this one hour presentation are for students to inspire a culture of belonging, action and kindness; encourage reflection and action based on stewardship; build resilience and provide wellness tools and to; foster respect towards self, community and others.

There is a new adventure coming to Round Hill School! The Grade 8 class is presently raising money to travel to other parts of Canada next year! We have registered with BRSD to have an **Educational Travel Club** and approval has been granted for the students to go to Quebec and Ontario in March of 2025. This educational trip correlates with the social studies curriculum for grade 9 students.

Canadian country recording artist and five times Saskatchewan Country Music Association Award winner, **Justin LaBrash**, will be performing a run of acoustic shows in the Camrose area the week of May 14 to 17. While he is in the neighbourhood during a school weekday, he likes to offer his services to local schools. In this case, he has offered his performance for half of what he typically asks! The Incredible YOU is a school-based Sexual Abuse Education program for K-6 students. Presentations to students were made May 7-9 at Round Hill School. It is offered by the Association for Communities Against Abuse to empower children and those in their lives to recognize their rights and ownership of their bodies. The junior high students received the same message but their presentation also included the internet and the dangers present there.

The provincial government has decided to cancel **Provincial Achievement Tests** at the grade 6 level this year. Math and language tests are canceled across the province. As well, because our students are piloting the new science curriculum, our students will not write a PAT in science. The only PAT our Grade 6 students will write will be in social studies.

Success Starts Early is a program throughout BRSD that offers support to students coming into Kindergarten next year. On May 3rd, these students were invited to the school for things like vision testing and assessment in Speech and Language. The goal of this program is to assess early so support can be put in place for when these students start school next September. By all accounts, this day was a great success. Over the past few weeks you would have seen two important pieces of paperwork come home. The first was provided to families whose children will be in grades 4-9 next year. If our sports program is going to thrive, we will need parents to drive. Please fill out the form, "**Transportation in Private Vehicles**", so you are able to drive students to sporting events and field trips in 24/25!

Do you want to supervise your child's field trip? Another form that was sent home to many households was the "**Agent of the Board**", which you need to fill out in order to supervise field trips. This process involves submitting a Criminal Record Check and Child Intervention Check. If you need copies of either of these documents, simply contact the school.

The Grade 5 and 6 students will be heading to **Ranch Camp** on the 27th and 28th of May. They will be attending the Circle Square Ranch which is down near Halkirk. A big thanks to our Society of Parents of Round Hill School for financially supporting this trip!

It is Spring, we have just received our "million dollar rain" and it will soon be time to **plant the garden**! Our students will be planting in our community garden on May 16th. All the students will get the opportunity to plant during this day. More information on what time your child will be at the garden will be communicated to you by your child as we get closer to the date.
